## SCRIPTURE FOCUS

*Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for he is faithful that promised*

*Romans 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness, and with the mouth, confession is made unto salvation.*

*2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear, but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.*

*Luke 12:32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom*

*Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.*

*Romans 4:17 ...him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.*

*1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.*

*Hebrews 11:1 Now Faith is the substance of things hoped for the evidence of things not seen*

## PROCEDURE

Call in and introduce yourself. The first few minutes will be greeting and welcoming those who have joined the call. Please feel free to give a brief testimony at the beginning of the call. Enter His courts with PRAISE!

## FOCUS

This month I want to focus on:

“Hold Fast the Confession of Our Faith!”

When God created man in His own image and likeness He gave man the incredible power of words. When man believes in his heart and confesses with his mouth; he will have or create whatever he says!

Our confessions should always be in line with God's will; which will create and produce the life that God has intended for us. However, if we believe wrong things then our confession will work against us.

Faith and fear work exactly alike. When in faith we believe and confess all that God has for us. When in fear we believe and confess just the opposite. FEAR—False Evidence Appearing Real. FAITH—True Evidence of things hoped for, evidence of things not seen. Both Faith and Fear believe in evidence not seen.

Don't confess anything that you don't want in your life. Hold fast the confession of your faith for the things that you do want. Fear causes you to be selfish and hold back; while love causes you to give to others and casts out fear.

## PRAYER FOCUS ... pray that you will

- Realize the power of your words and how they will create for you either in a positive way or a negative way.
- Recognize that every confession you make throughout the day comes from what you believe.
- Become more aware of what type of confessions you make throughout the day and change them from fear to faith.
- Begin to believe and confess only things that you truly want to come to pass in your life.
- Recognize throughout your day when you are speaking from fear or from faith.
- Confess only what you want to happen and not those things that you are afraid will happen.
- Call things that be not as though they were.
- Mature in the love of God, which will remove fear from your life, and “hold fast to your confession of faith!”
